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1. The stated terms and conditions that you are abiding by that follow on this documentation may change at anytime with or without notice. Please make sure you check the website (<http://www.rockthehill.org.au>) or contact us for the most recent documentation available.
2. Please be advised that all material below that includes reference to the Rock The Hill website any content is listed under the domain "rockthehill.org.au". This information also includes all sub-domain names included with this domain; public or private. Any information held outside this website domain name is to be regarded as non-official and non recent. Rock The Hill does have a fan / friends website which can be located via the myspace.com domain name, which is the following: "www.myspace.com/rockthehill". The information that you may find on the Rock The Hill Myspace website is also to be regarded as non-recent. All comments within are posted by their respective owners and are to be regarded as non-official posts.
3. Any names; brands; companies; businesses; trademarks or registered entities are copyright to themselves and they hold all legal capacity, all names are copyright to their respective owners. Rock The Hill has no association with their names or legal connections. Rock The Hill is a fully independent body from these organizations.
4. All bands playing at Rock The Hill understand:
 - a. Rock The Hill is a FReeZA endorsed Drug & Alcohol free event
 - Alcohol and Drugs will not be allowed on the premises and no person under the influence of alcohol or other drugs will be admitted. This includes performers, crew and friends, sub-contactors, event staff, committee members or general attendees.
 - b. Bands or Soloists playing at Rock The Hill are not given any monetary funding for being involved in and or playing at Rock The Hill. Although transportation funding maybe given to each band.
 - c. No pass outs will be available to anyone during the event, including performers; band passes are for back stage access only.
 - d. A Maximum of 1 free roadie to each band applies. This means you are able to admit (through main entrance of event) 1 person into the Rock The Hill event for free, as support for your band. Their name(s) have to be fully listed on the technical information form provided to you, otherwise they will not be permitted to enter with band list approval. Roadies and Band members will be given specified passes to wear throughout the night. Anyone caught not wearing a pass in restricted areas will be ejected from the venue / area.

5. All Bands must be at the event by Five Thirty pm (5:30pm). No Exceptions! This is to sort out any problems we may have to let the night run smoothly.
 - a. If you do not turn up by Five Thirty pm (5:30pm) and have not contacted one of the committee members (Denzil, Jake) by telephone, we have to assume that you are not playing and we will re-schedule the night to fill the gaps.
 - b. If you (the band), have multiple events happening through the day please notify us when returning the technical information form, or as soon as you are aware of this, so we are aware incase we have to re-schedule the band spaces.
 - c. If you are running late to attend Rock The Hill by Five Thirty pm, please notify one of the band coordinators or administrators below.
 - d. You have been specified a spot which you are playing through the night;
 - i. If you have organized to share or use another band's equipment through the night (and the other band is also playing) please inform us of this, so we can put you next to each other in the running order.
6. Rock The Hill Productions takes no responsibility for any lost equipment that takes place at Rock The Hill. It is solely the responsibility of the band members to keep equipment where appropriately designated. You are assigned a position where your equipment must stay throughout the night unless it is on stage when you are playing.
7. Please send all forms back to us within one week of receiving them.
8. Please make sure all bookings and information are directed to the correct department. Any false information or transferred information between any parties via the wrong department may result in mis-leading or incorrect information given. To find out about the most recent and correct information, please access our website (<http://www.rockthehill.org.au>) or contact us directly via the media at the end of this documentation. Contacting a Rock The Hill committee member in the area that is relevant to your enquiry can be made via the Rock The Hill website (<http://www.rockthehill.org.au>).
9. The use of offensive language is not acceptable, unless it is within the built-in context of a song. The use of any form of offensive, derogatory or abusive language is not allowed. If your band is seen to be using offensive language, you may be cautioned or promptly removed from the stage and venue by event staff.

In the case of any recording or broadcast material within the venue, guidelines for offensive language will be tighter. If you would like more information on our policies towards this matter, please contact us.
10. Rock The Hill is now officially a smoke free event. Anyone found smoking within or 20 metres around the perimeter of the Rock The Hill venue will be escorted by the Security Staff on duty off the premises and to a safe zone outside the perimeter of the event. It is now an offence to be smoking within the perimeter of the event and you maybe faced with local law justice and fines.

11. Verbal, racial or physical abuse committed by any member within the Rock The Hill venue will be ejected from the venue by event staff and you maybe handed over to the police in the event of serious problem. If you find yourself in the situation of giving this abuse to another member of the public or Rock The Hill committee, please be advised of how serious all types of abuse is, you will be treated in accordance with the law. Be aware Rock The Hill does not condone any forms of derogatory, abusive or violent actions to any member of the public and Rock The Hill organisation.
